A happy tradition and harbinger of spring, the Patton Valley Rosé release reminds us that somewhere beyond the gloom is a spring and summer just waiting to be enjoyed. The 2014 season was optimal for growing just about anything. Nice warm and dry days sped up the ripening, and allowed us to pick much earlier than in previous years. That early pick is a conscious stylistic choice for us at Patton Valley, as the preservation of acidity and minerality is crucial to making the style of rosé that we love.

The 2014 Patton Valley Vineyard Rosé of Pinot Noir leads with citrus aromas of tangerine, grapefruit, orange marmalade and lime, but builds with cantaloupe and pear. Flavors of nectarine and candied lemon grace the pleasingly broad palate. The wine finishes with the lightness of cream soda and orange oil. The hallmark of every great Patton Valley rosé is the acidity, and this wine does not disappoint. The flavors are taken long through the finish with mouthwatering acidity and a light effervescence that makes the wine dance on our tongues.
